## INTRODUCING THE SPEAKERS

**Michael Showalter** has worked at the PA State Museum in Harrisburg, and, for the past 25 years, has been the Museum Educator at the historic Ephrata Cloister Museum. He holds a BA in history from Millersville University and an MA in American Studies from Penn State University. The theme of his five-week presentation will be “All that can, invite to a pastoral life: Early Lancaster County.”

**Dr. Lee Barrett** is professor of Systematic Theology at Lancaster Theological Seminary and a popular speaker at Heritage & Horizons.

**Rob Bresler** is Professor Emeritus of Public Policy at Penn State University, Harrisburg. He is also an avid film historian.

**Larry Alexander**, a native of Ephrata, PA, is a former news reporter for the Lancaster Intelligencer and New Era. He currently writes a weekly column for the Ephrata Review. Larry is the author of *Biggest Brother: The Life of Major Dick Winters, the Man Who Led the Band of Brothers*. It was published in 2005 and made the New York Times Best Seller list.
