Guide Lines & Procedures

- 1. Arrangements for burials may be made through a Pastor.
- 2. Only cremated remains are to be buried in the Memorial Garden.
- 3. The garden is intended for the use of Church of the Apostles members and their immediate families. Exceptions can be made with the approval of a Pastor or Church Council.
- 4. Cremated remains are to be buried in biodegradable containers. Ceramic, stone or metal containers will not be permitted.
- 5. No marker will be placed at the burial site. A bronze plaque, inscribed with the name of the deceased and the dates of birth and death will be placed on the south exterior wall of Fellowship Hall. Spouses may reserve spaces alongside each other.
- 6. A \$100 minimum donation is requested for the maintenance and future improvements of the Garden. Another \$100 is requested for the bronze plaque.
