

### 2021 Garage Sale





## **Covid Update**

Re-opening Task Force has revisited the initial metric of a 10% positivity rate as the marker for closing down inside service. At this point, the vaccination rate in our older and vulnerable members is increasing, so we feel comfortable in recommending continued monitoring of the recommendations of the PA Dept of Health and the CDC. Members have been very good about complying with all mitigation measures including mask use at our indoor services. Beginning in May, members will have a choice of an outdoor service if that is most comfortable for them. There is a good variety of options for participating in the indoor services virtually including Facebook, YouTube and Worshiping by Phone if in-person attendance is not comfortable for a member.

We recently had a vaccine clinic for our members and the community at the church on 4/25/21. Melissa Koehler, our member who owns the Hillcrest Pharmacy, is willing to schedule vaccine appointments at her location in Mountville. We encourage members who are still seeking a vaccination to seek out an appointment through the Vaccinate Lancaster web site. Tom Weaver from our church is also willing to assist any member seeking help getting an appointment for the COVID-19 vaccine.
